### ● Dynamic rules engine

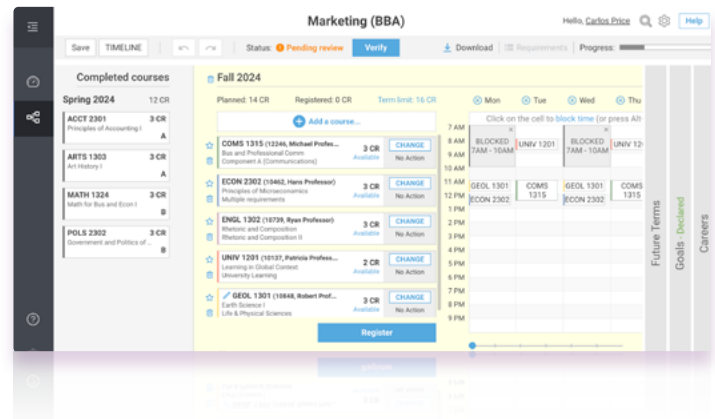
Make rules for sequencing, program requirements, and course relationships (e.g. Courses A and B cannot be taken in the same term).
